Sports

“What can be learned on the ground cannot be learned in the classroom.” Our schools lay a strong emphasis on sports and physical development. Our sports curriculum is planned and designed for students to develop and enhance skills like strength, speed, endurance, agility, flexibility, control, balance etc. We offer a variety of sports like football, volleyball, handball and athletics. We have weekly achievable goals for the different skills required for a particular sport and train students accordingly. Inter school matches are conducted.

Art

Appointment for Principal & Teachers

Prior appointment from the front office (minimum one day in advance) is necessary for meeting. The Principal or the supervisor. Parents can also initiate a meeting with the teacher by an appointment in special cases. Emergency cases will be taken on priority.

English Communication & Public Speaking

Public speaking is crucial as it enhances communication skills, builds confidence, advances, careers, influences and persuades others, sharpens critical thinking provides networking opportunities and fosters personal growth.

Field Trip

Field trips are within city limits and planned, reviewed and monitored by the school pannel to ensure the safety of the students.

Field trips are included as part of the fees.

Consent form duly filled and signed by the parent is mandatory. In case of any mishap, school will not be held responsible.

These make learning enriching, thereby providing a skill based foundation wherein the students are exposed to the real life experience.

School Policies

Uniforms

- Students must be in complete uniform on all school working days.
- The PE uniform must be worn on PE days only and on days specified by the school authority.
- Earrings: Only studs will be allowed (for girls only).
- Chains and lockets: Religious lockets only in black thread are permitted but it should not be visible.
- Hair: Shoulder length and long hair should be neatly tied, braided or pushed back with a white hair band. Students with unkempt hair do not pose a good appearance.
- Application of Mehendi is permissible but only on the palms with prior permission from the School authority. No tattoos or nail polish is allowed. No friendship band is allowed.
- No child without proper uniform & ID will be allowed into the school, unless prior permission is taken.

Arrival and Dispersal

- No child is allowed to enter insides the school after morning prayer. Gates will be closed after 7.10 a.m.
- Students using private transport need to cooperate with the school to avoid traffic congestion outside school.
- Every student will go home only by authorised transport or with an authorised escort. Regarding authorisation of escort, parents are requested to submit a written authorisation letter.
- The school should be informed immediately in writing about the change of authorised escort. Verbal messages will not be entertained. The same should be intimated at the Clerk Office.
- School timing 7.00 am to 12.20 p.m. from Monday to Friday and Saturday upto 9.50 am.

Attendance

- 75% attendance (working days) during the academic year is a prerequisite for promotion to the next grade level.

- The school reserves the right to withhold promotion in case the minimum requirement is not fulfilled.
- All Students are expected to attend the first and the last day of school for every academic session.
- Attendance at official school functions such as Sports day, Annual day, Independence day, Republic day is compulsory.

Absenteeism

- Students may be absent from school only for essential and important reasons, such as illness or an emergency in the family.
- Prior permission from the school is required for leave for more than 2 days.
- Leave note provided in the diary should be duly filled by Parent/Guardian and submitted to the teacher. However, absence longer than 3 days will also require medical certificate.
- In the event of a planned absence, parents are requested to seek prior permission of the Principal / Vice Principal / Academic Coordinator before proceeding on leave.
- A student will not be allowed to leave the school during school hours unless he/she produces a note in the diary signed by his/her parents giving valid reasons.
- Request for half-day leave will not be entertained unless extremely urgent.
- Medical appointments should be made after school hours unless there is an emergency.

Admission and Withdrawal

Admission fees is non refundable under any circumstances. Parents / Guardians need to submit a written application for a School leaving Certificate. A minimum ONE month notice is required for the same. The School Leaving Certificate will be issued only after all dues are cleared and library books are returned.

School Leaving Certificate may not be issued for the following reasons:

- Non payment of fees and / or other dues.

For duplicate TC and Report Card, an amount will be charged.

Urgent Closing

In case of any civil disturbance, or an emergency, do not send your child to school. Should an emergency situation occur during school hours, the students will be kept in the campus until parents can pick them up.

Bonafide Certificate

A written application with the details required for the same to be sent to the Clerk Office Executive at least a week before you need the same.

Birthday Celebrations

Students of grade V to X are permitted to wear festive dresses on birthdays.

Student may distribute common fruits/sweets (avoid chocolates) to their classmates and teachers. Distribution of toys/gifts and cutting of cake is not allowed.

Refund

FEES ONCE PAID ARE NEITHER REFUNDABLE NOR TRANSFERABLE.

Additional Charges and Contribution

Additional charges will be levied for items that are not included in the school budget provision, including but not limited to the following:

- Trips and Activities (to cover cost of travel, entrance fees and any other activities.)
- Extended day programmes, extracurricular activities, annual days, arts and sport competitions etc.
- Event & external examination fees, enrollment and registration charges and expenses where the event and exams are conducted.

Religious Policy

At school, students learn that spirituality is the soul of all religions.

Health and Wellness

- Health and safety of all students is a matter of deep concern and of prime importance to the school and the parents.
- If any medication is administered to your child, a diary notification or a phone call will be made.
- The school needs to be intimated if their child is absent due to illness and the specifics of the illness. A medical certificate from the doctor should be submitted to the school. Parents are expected to keep the school updated with regards of their child's medical records.

- The child should not be sent to school if he/she is unwell in the morning. If a child is deemed to be unwell while at school; parents will be contacted and asked to collect the child.
- If a child requires any medicines to be administered during school hours, please make a written request to the school. No verbal request will be considered for the same.
- Students suffering from infectious diseases like scabies, conjunctivitis, dermatitis, etc., should not be sent to school.
- In the interest of everyone concerned during epidemics the school reserves the right to deny permission to attend class.

Prefects Student Council

- The school believes in inculcating a sense of self-discipline and self-governance and therefore elects a Student Council Body.
- The Student Council is a organisation of students elected to represent the student body in decision-making regarding student affairs and school activities.

School Behaviour Policy

The School Behaviour Management Strategy circles around Prevention, Correction and Support. It reflects and demonstrates school commitment to promoting quality education and care for the students.

- English is the medium of communication. Students are expected to speak in English in the school premises.
- Change has the first bell is the signal for students to leave for the assembly.
- Visiting the washroom should be restricted to the cause.
- Shouting, running, whistling in the corridor is not allowed.
- Expensive things such as fancy stationery should not to be brought to the school.
- Borrowing and lending of money is not permitted in school.
- Students are responsible for the safe custody of their own books and belongings. Each article should be marked with the student's name.
- No student is allowed to write his/her name or leave any indelible marks on the furniture / chalk board. Before leaving the classroom students should pick up any waste paper and unwanted material lying on the floor and drop it in the dustbins provided.
- The school is very proactive in terms of behaviour management, anti-bullying and child protection. If a problem arises, appropriate action will be taken after thorough investigation by the concerned committee and the principal.

Infractions and Disciplinary Action at Dr. Babasaheb Ambedkar Vidyalaya

Special Education & Counseling

The Special Education and Counseling department focuses on providing tailored educational support and mental health services to students with diverse needs. Special education addresses the unique learning requirements of students with

disabilities, ensuring they receive appropriate resources and accommodations. Counseling services complement this by offering emotional and psychological support, helping students navigate personal challenges and enhancing their overall well-being. Together, these services aim to foster an inclusive and supportive learning environment where every student can thrive.

Gate Security

- Unauthorised entry of men, materials and vehicles is strictly prohibited.
- It is mandatory for every member of the school community to wear his/her ID card.
- All the security related registers are maintained as per the School SOPs.

Fire Safety

- The entire school is equipped with sufficient Fire Extinguishers/Fire buckets and Fire Hydrants of hose pipe and hose reel as per the Fire department policy in schools.
- The fire equipments are checked and maintained from time to time.

Parent Teacher Meeting

A Parent Teacher Meeting is a short meeting or conference between the parents and teachers to discuss the student's progress at school and find solutions to academic or behavioural problems.

- Meetings of parents with teachers are arranged by the school as per the schedule, in order to ensure coordination in the process of the child's education. Parents are requested to make good use of this opportunity for building up mutual understanding between the parents and teachers with regard to the progress of their wards.
- Remarks by the teachers on the PTM registers must be read and duly signed by the parents.

Parent Portal

- Acadmin is the Parent Portal that provides parents with complete information about the academic activities of their wards during the year.
- It includes information HW, announcements, assignments, worksheets.
- Circulars, Results, Events, Holidays, Achievements, Fees and other activities are updated regularly.

- Every student has individual and exclusive ID and Password. The enrollment no. is the ID.
- Parents are required to check the portal on a daily basis.

Imp. Message to the Parents

Working closely with parents and guardians is a priority for us at our schools. - Ensure that your ward appears for all the tests / competitions / Events as per schedule given.
- Refer to the school diary for the holidays observed by the school. Any change in the holidays will be communicated to you through the parent portal.
- Please refrain from sending lunch boxes / notebooks during school hours.
- Parents are not permitted to interact with teachers or students during school hours.
- Entry for parents and visitors is restricted to the School Reception Area. Visit to the academic wing will not be allowed on regular days.
- As co-educators of the child, it is very essential for you to observe the dress code when you are in the school premises.

- Criticism of teachers of the school in front of wards / other parents is to be strictly avoided as it causes the students to lose respect for the teachers.
- Parents should avoid using the school as a meeting place for airing grievances. Written communication to the school authorities will be appreciated.
